The Hunter's Run Watershed Sponsors are working in cooperation with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to develop a plan for rehabilitating the Hunter's Run Watershed Dams 4 and 9 in Fairfield County, Ohio. Dam No. 4 is located on Stonewall Creek, a tributary to Hunter's Run southwest of Lancaster off US 22 on Stonewall Cemetery Rd. Dam No. 9 is located on the Hocking River near Historic Rock Mill, upstream of the community of Hooker.

A public meeting will be held to discuss the dam rehabilitation program, planning activities to date, the various alternatives to be evaluated, the recommended alternatives, and the planning schedule. NRCS and Sponsors, along with their consultants, will present detailed information and discuss your questions and concerns. Please plan to participate.
